

Position:	Youth Worker
Location:	The Well Community Church
Hours:	24 hours per week
Contract:	1 year renewable contract

PURPOSE OF POST

- To be responsible for the development and delivery of the youth work programme for the 11–18 year olds within The Well Community Church.
- To lead the youth core team of the Well Community Church, establishing and developing a culture of discipleship and mission among young people in line with the vision of the church.
- To establish links with local young people for the purpose of evangelism.

CORE TASKS

- **1.** Co-ordinate Youth Team including: recruiting, training and maintaining the volunteer team; envisioning, equipping and motivating them to deliver the youth programme.
- **2.** Be actively involved in the life of the church: serving, leading and speaking at Sunday gatherings as required.
- **3.** Mobilise the youth to be actively involved in the life of church and missional communities. Facilitate opportunities for them to serve and be discipled.
- **4.** Oversee Sunday and mid-week groups, ensuring that they are well led and adhere to the vision.
- **5.** To initiate and lead the planning of any youth mission and residential discipleship trips e.g. Soul Survivor (5 days), youth weekends away, short-term mission teams. At least one of these is expected each year.
- 6. Develop and manage the youth budget.
- **7.** Maintain and develop the youth database and ensure good communications with youth/church.
- **8.** Network with local churches and youth organisations as agreed with your line manager.
- **9.** Any other reasonable tasks as requested by your line manager and leadership team.

PERSONAL SPECIFICATION

- Is a committed Christian.
- Has excellent communication, interpersonal and relational skills.
- Is able to take initiative and be self-motivated.
- Is able to manage their time well.
- Is teachable and willing to be mentored.
- Desires to see young people discipled and living missionally.
- Has experience leading a work with young people both within the church and in the wider community.
- Has the ability to work as a part of a number of different teams, and relate to people of all ages and different backgrounds.
- Has experience of successfully recruiting, inspiring and developing a team of volunteers.
